MARCH 2022 LABOUR FORCE SURVEY

In March 2022, Canada gained 93,000 full-time jobs and 73,000 jobs overall. Canada's unemployment rate, as of March 2022, is now 5.3% - the lowest it's been since 1976 when this type of data was first collected.

OUR 2030 EMISSIONS PLAN

The 2030 Emissions Reduction Plan is an ambitious achievable roadmap that outlines a sector-by-sector plan for Canada to reach its emissions reduction target of 40% below 2005 levels by 2030 and net-zero emissions by 2050 by:

- Making it easier to switch to electric vehicles
- Embracing the power of nature to fight climate change
- Reducing oil & gas emissions
- Greening our homes & buildings
- Making our electricity grid cleaner
- Empowering communities to take climate action
- Supporting farmers in building a clean, prosperous future
