THE OPIOID CRISIS

"British Columbia has been seized by the opioid crisis... It does not matter whether we are rich or poor, urban or rural, likely we know someone who has either lost their life or been touched in

some way by this awful crisis.
The impact of the opioid crisis is devastating individuals, families and communities... stigma remains a huge barrier to ensuring people- who-use-drugs can receive safe, culturally

competent and trauma -informed care. Harm reduction, safe supply and addressing this as a health care issue is what we must do." - Feb. 8, 2022
